The minimum grade required in each prerequisite course is a C- or 60% or equivalent for Undergraduate level courses. This is a CMA Canada Accredited Program. Completion of all the courses listed below through this program with a B (75%) average provides a waiver of the CMA Entrance Examination for a period of three years from date of graduation.
