

The Respectful Workplace – Responding to Bill 168 – Workplace Harassment and Violence

As professionals, we touch many aspects of the business workplace, and keeping up to relevant new Health and Safety changes is vital to our success.

Bill 168 came into effect on June 15, 2010. This Act amended the Occupational Health and Safety Act, with respect to violence and harassment in the workplace. Every employer in Ontario, where more than five workers are employed, are required to take steps, including developing a violence risk assessment and implementing a policy and program, to prevent and manage workplace violence and harassment.

This is a two-hour presentation by Gary Phillips, MA, CRSP, CHRP, NLP Licensed Trainer. He will provide a detailed review of legal obligations, with respect to assessment, policy, accountability, and implementation. The presentation will also cover organizational policy, recognizing harassment, bullying and lack of respect, within the context of organizational culture. Gary will also touch on interpersonal relations and communication aspects of perceptions of harassment and bullying.
